2012 Bush Hog Specifications

- Fill out a per-one-time mowing of the Winchester Airport grounds on the first line of the bid submittal form. A minimum of five (5) per-one-time mowings will be granted to the winning bidder. Submit your bid for the total price for five (5) mowings on the third line of the bid submittal form. Additional one-time mowings may be requested, as needed, based on the per-one-time mowing price on the Bid Submittal Form.
- The term of the mowing contract is for the calendar year of 2012.
- For reference, the main airport property is approximately 6,200 feet long, north to south. Total mowing acreage is approximately 200-225 acres.
- Bidder must be able to commence mowing operations within two (2) weeks upon the request of the Airport Manager. (Time may be extended at the Airport Manager's discretion due to weather or airport events.)
- Bidder must be able to fully complete each one-time mowing within two (2) days. (Time may be extended at the Airport Manager's discretion due to weather or airport events.)
- The areas to be mowed are designated on the attached document. All designated areas must be cut no higher than three (3) inches.
- Once the contract is granted the winning bidder may be able to omit certain areas to be mowed due to a potentially hazardous condition; however, only with the Airport Manager's permission.
- Once the contract is granted the winning bidder will not be permitted to operate equipment upon or within ten (10) feet of areas indicated as runway or ramp areas.
- Once the contract is granted the winning bidder can only operate equipment inspected and approved by the Airport Manager. (For the safety to airmen and ramped aircraft.)
- Once the contract is granted the winning bidder shall be allowed to store equipment in a designated area of the Airport designated by the Airport Manager for a period of no more than four (4) days.
- It is at the Airport Manager's discretion to terminate any contract granted to any persons due to safety concerns or breach of contract. (Appeals may be granted through the Winchester Airport Authority)
